Dear OGQ supporters,

It was in the year 2000 that the idea of creating OGQ was born in my mind, on my return flight from Sydney where I was part of a dinner hosted for the Indian Olympic Contingent. Whilst Prakash and I formed the entity in 2001 it was only in 2007 that we received our first funding.

But the growth since then has been most rewarding and humbling and I can't thank you enough for being such solid supporters and believers in the OGQ mission.

The OGQ team has already identified high performance athletes who will be peaking at LA 2028 and are working with full focus and energy to provide them 'whatever is required' to achieve their full potential.

We have also tied up the services of some of the best foreign coaches in the world to work with the athletes in their respective disciplines.

The OGQ Coaches Program, now in its eighth year of running, is focusing on upskilling Indian coaches so that in the long run we can have our top juniors train under high quality Indian coaches.

At the grassroots we are supporting several academies across sports but the one that I am most excited about is the 'Weightlifting Warriors' programme to identify and nurture the next Mirabai Chanu.



Whilst the Paris Paralympics was outstanding, we could have done better in the 2024 Paris Olympics. My Board and I are optimistic about India reaching the double figure mark in the LA medal tally.

I thank my board for their deep involvement and belief in this cause as also our world class 120 member team on the ground led by the mercurial and intense Viren Rasquinha. Most importantly I thank our athletes who defy all odds to give their best for India.

# RASOUINHA

**OLYMPIAN & FORMER INDIA HOCKEY CAPTAIN:** MD & CEO, OGQ

This last year was a bit of an emotional rollercoaster for me personally. Some key stats from the Paris Olympics and Paralympics:

- 49 athletes and 54 para athletes supported by OGQ qualified for the Paris Olympics and Paralympics respectively.
- The corresponding numbers were 29 and 24 respectively at Tokyo 2020.
- 4 out of 6 medal winners at the Olympics were supported by OGQ.
- 25 out of 29 medal winners at the Paralympics were supported by OGQ.
- Indian athletes finished Top 8 in 23 events at the Paris Olympics. Athletes in 18 of these events were supported by OGQ.

There were so many moments of joy at these mega events. Manu Bhakar won two Olympic medals in Pistol Shooting and became the first Indian athlete in history to win two medals at the same edition of an Olympics. This is one of the greatest case studies of a sporting comeback after her disappointment at Tokyo.

Aman Sehrawat won the bronze medal in Wrestling Men's 57 kgs and at the age of just 21 years, became the youngest Indian sportsperson ever to win an individual Olympic medal.

OGQ has been supporting Manu and Aman since they were 15 years old through our OGQ Junior Program and it has been a long journey with plenty of ups and downs.



The Para athletes brought such immense joy to everybody with an exceptional performance of 29 medals at Paris, up from 19 medals at Tokyo. Our OGQ Para program is 6 years old and we now support more than 100 para athletes. It has been an incredible story of resilience and grit. Armless para archer Sheetal Devi (Mixed Team Compound Open) who won the bronze medal and many other Para athletes like **Navdeep Singh** (Gold medal in Para Javelin Short Stature), Avani Lekhara (Gold Medal in the 10m Air Rifle - Wheelchair User) teach us that nothing is impossible.


Sport can sometimes be beautiful and sometimes brutal. 6 athletes at the Paris Olympics finished in fourth place and missed a medal by a whisker. For all these six athletes, it was a case of so near and yet so far.

We are taking all the lessons from Paris and will keep fighting as we build towards LA2028.





### Wrestling:

A Medal Every Time Since 2008 India's Olympic medal streak in wrestling continued at Paris 2024 with Aman Sehrawat's bronze - making it five consecutive Olympic Games with a podium finish. OGQ has been supporting since he was 15 years old.





### **Setback at Tokyo Olympics**

In the 10m Air Pistol Women qualification, her pistol malfunctioned mid- event—a rare and uncontrollable incident.

This disrupted her rhythm and she failed to qualify for the finals.

### **Mental Training**

OGQ worked closely with Manu on sports psychology to help her recover from the setback from the Tokyo Olympics.

### **Sports Science**

Physiotherapy for post-training recovery; Strength and conditioning tailored for pistol shooting posture and stability; Nutrition & supplement plans to ensure efficient management of training loads.

### **Climbing Back**

Won a Bronze medal at the ISSF Shooting World Cup at Bhopal in the 25m Pistol event.

This was her first ever senior international medal in this event and a significant one for her confidence.

### **Backed by Expert Coaching**

OGQ supported Manu in training under coach Jaspal Rana - 1996 Olympian and 4X medalist at 2006 Asian Games.

"I was very grateful that I got the OGQ support at a very early stage of my career. Post the Tokyo Olympics, things were not great and I was not happy because of my performance. It was a tough period to go through, however, the one thing that stayed consistent with me was the unwavering support and belief of the OGQ team. Playing three events in shooting is a very tough task and the OGQ sports science team ensured that I'm recovering very well after training and matches. Even at the Olympics, the team's presence helped me a lot with my preparation."

### **Targeted Mental Training**

Missed out on the Asian Games medal due to one bad shot and finished 4th.

After the setback at major competitions, OGQ supported Swapnil with a sports psychologist, Vaibhav Agashe, who had previously worked with Gagan Narang ahead of his London 2012 medal. This helped Swapnil build consistency under pressure.

### **Equipment Support**

In the run up to Paris Olympics, OGQ facilitated rifle and ammunition testing in Germany.

### **Nutrition**

Between 2023-24, OGQ nutritionists worked extensively with Swapnil to help tackle dietary challenges that affected his sleep and recovery. The team identified travel friendly foods & safe options in the Olympic Village for Swapnil to consume, ensuring optimum energy levels.

"OGQ has played a vital role in my journey to the Olympic medal. The support from nutritionists, physios and athlete managers has been immense and they have stood like a solid team with me every step of the way. Especially after the Asian Games, when my confidence level wasn't great the team showed immense faith in my abilities and skill to ensure that I continue to perform at the highest level. In the Olympics village, the planning from sports science in terms of selecting the right food options and timely recovery sessions with the physios ensured that I only focused on the technical aspects of my game."

### **OGQ begins Support:**

Inducted into the OGQ Junior Program at the age of 15. OGQ supported Aman with a monthly stipend to help him sustain his day to day expenses at the Chhatrasal Wrestling Academy.

Won a bronze medal at the U17 World Championships, Croatia in the same year.

OGQ nutritionists began working with Aman to ensure adequate nutrition for his growth & recovery.



### **Targets Paris Olympics:**

Won **Gold** at the U17 Asian Championships in Kazakhstan.

### Inspired by Ravi Dahiya's Olympic medal

### **Foreign Coaching:**

OGQ arranged for Aman to train under Russian coach Ali Shabanau in Dagestan to fine tune his techniques as per global best standards in wrestling. This was followed by:

- Gold at the Senior Asian Championships in Kazakhstan.
- Bronze at the Asian Games, China.

### **Won Quota for Paris Olympics 2024:** Defeated his idol Ravi Dahiya in domestic trials to qualify for the Paris Olympics.

"In my journey from the Chhatrasal Stadium to the Olympics medal at Paris, OGQ has played a very important role. Back in 2018, when I joined OGQ one of the first things that helped me was the stipend money through which I could pay the mess fees at the academy and I could also support my sister's education. This was a moment of self pride that I could finally take care of myself and my sister. A year before the Olympics OGQ also helped me to improve the technical aspects of my game through a foreign training camp in Russia. This camp gave me a lot of self confidence as I felt I could now take on any opponent on the world stage."



### **Early Background**

Orphaned at the age of 11, Aman nearly gave up on wrestling before finding a second home at Chhatrasal Stadium. Trained in humble conditions, Aman's early years were marked by hardship - but also unwavering drive.

### **Early Background**

Born in Buana Lakhu, a small village in Haryana, Navdeep grew up feeling isolated. Mocked for his short stature, he often stayed indoors, unsure of his place in the world. Sport changed that. Encouraged by his father, a former national-level wrestler, and inspired by para-athlete Sandeep Chaudhary, Navdeep turned to javelin—and began to believe he could become something more.

**OGQ started supporting Navdeep** as a 20 year old in 2020.

### **Injury Support &**

**Targeted Strength Training:** With a focus on core, hip, and rotator cuff strengthening, his mobility improved significantly, reducing injury risk and supporting better performance during intense training

### **Personalised Nutrition:**

He initially followed a generic diet based on others' routines. Later a personalized plan was created. tailored to his body, training needs, and restrictions—boosting energy, recovery, and performance.

### **Mental Conditioning:**

Navdeep worked one-on-one with psychologist Mugdha Bavare to overcome the fear of finishing 4th again. Her support also helped him stay emotionally steady after the loss of his father, just two months before Paris.

### **On-ground Coaching Support:**

In the final phase before Paris, Navdeep trained under Coach Sunil Tanwar at SAI Gandhinagar, focusing on fine-tuning technique and consistently reaching medal-range throws above 45m.

### **Early Life and Journey to Shooting**

Mona Agarwal was born on 8th November 1987 in Sikar, Rajasthan. A reaction to polio drops at a young age affected both her legs, requiring fullleg calipers and hand support to walk. After years of determined effort, she was able to balance with just one caliper and a stick—but later had to start using a wheelchair.

A mother of two, Mona explored various sports including powerlifting and sitting volleyball before discovering shooting in December 2021. She took to it with discipline and belief, despite limited resources and late entry into the sport.

**Training, Recovery & Equipment** 

OGQ began supporting Mona in October 2023, during a crucial phase in her qualification journey for the Paris Paralympics.

Financial support through stipend helped her manage training expenses and recovery routines.

Strength & Conditioning (S&C) helped prevent fatigue and enhanced post-match recovery.

High-quality rifle provided for the 10m event, giving her a competitive edge.

**Backup equipment** reduced performance anxiety during training and competition.

**International exposure** to events like the World Cup in Changwon, Korea, where she won Gold.



# IMPACT OF FOREIGN

For para athletes competing in highly technical events like the high jump, access to global expertise can make all the difference. In 2024, OGQ identified a key gap in elite technical coaching and moved quickly to fill it. In partnership with the Government's TOPS scheme, OGQ facilitated a 7month high-performance training stint for Mariyappan Thangavelu and Nishad Kumar at the US Olympic Training Center, Chula Vista, under world-renowned coach Jeremy Fischer.

### **Elite Foreign Coaching**

Focus Areas: Technique, Biomechanics, Global Exposure.

### **Integrated Physio Support**

## KOREAN COACH KIM HAG YONG

ARCHERY (RECURVE)

India's archery team achieved its best-ever Olympic finish in the mixed team event, placing fourth. While the result was not the desired one, OGQ saw the need for expert coaching to help athletes prepare better for LA 2028 and beyond.

To address this, OGQ brought in South Korean coach Kim Hag Yong, who has previously worked with the national teams of Hong Kong, Singapore, and South Korea, a country widely recognized as a dominant force in Olympic archery.

**Coach Kim is no stranger to India - his earlier** stint in 2017 saw him mentor archers like Dhiraj Bommadevara and Pravin Jadhav, both of whom went on to become Olympians.

## POWER THROW COACH PAUL WILSON

Over the past two years, OGQ has focused on developing junior athletes in power throw events like shot put, javelin, and discus throw, with strong medal potential for LA 2028 and Brisbane 2032.

To strengthen technical coaching, OGQ onboarded Paul Wilson, a renowned coach from York, England, with over 18 years of experience in power throws. He has coached top athletes, including Chase Ealey (USA), who was the Women's Shot Put World Champion in 2022 & 2023.

Paul visited India in December 2024 to assess junior talent at the National Championships in Bhubaneswar.

He is currently coaching six athletes supported by OGQ.

Wrestling is India's only sport to win a medal at each of the last five Olympics. Japan, a dominant force in wrestling, secured 11 out of 18 wrestling medals at Paris 2024 - including 5 golds from athletes who trained at the Nippon Sports Science Academy. OGQ partnered with Nippon Sports Science Academy, providing Indian wrestlers the opportunity to:

- Train and spar with world-class Japanese
- Absorb advanced technical expertise from elite coaches

Till date, seven wrestlers, including Olympic Bronze medalist Aman Sehrawat, have trained at Nippon Sports University. OGQ will be supporting more wrestlers to train at Nippon in the coming months.





In FY 2024–25, the Youth Boxing program at NCOE Rohtak continued to grow through a tripartite collaboration between SAI, Dani Sports Foundation (DSF), and OGQ.

### **Multinational Training Camp**

Held in August 2025, the Youth Camp hosted 12 top youth boxers from Kazakhstan and 15 from Uzbekistan, offering Indian athletes valuable international sparring experience in their age and weight categories.

**ASBC Asian Championships, Abu Dhabi** 5 Junior Girls and 2 Sub-Junior Boys have qualified to represent India in 2025.

**U-19 World Championships, USA, 2024**11 boxers represented India at the tournament and won a total of 2 Gold, 5 Silver and 3 Bronze.

The program is now focused on achieving podium finishes at the upcoming Asian Games, Japan and World Boxing Championships, Liverpool to be held in September 2025.






